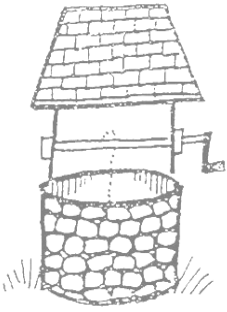


What do you know about our Covenant with the Poor here at Holy Cross?



The Wishing Well exists as part of the Parish of Holy Cross' Covenant with the Poor.
The seed was sewn 1997

It's a very simple idea - the best ones usually are!

- Throughout the year the parish fundraises in many different ways and this money is added to the Wishing Well fund.
- During the summer we put an advert in the local paper, inviting bids.
- We sponsor as Catholics. but not necessarily Catholic groups. They do, however, need to promote care and justice in our local area.
- In the Autumn, we invite parishioners and groups to come along to Holy Cross, after Sunday Mass, and cheques are distributed. Over £5,000 each year is given out.
- The well is then empty and needs to be replenished so another year of fundraising begins!
- The money is used to brighten people's lives in Eastleigh - loving our neighbour in action! Among the many who 'draw' from the well are groups who work with, the blind, the deaf, the bereaved, the lonely, the elderly, carers and adults with learning difficulties.
